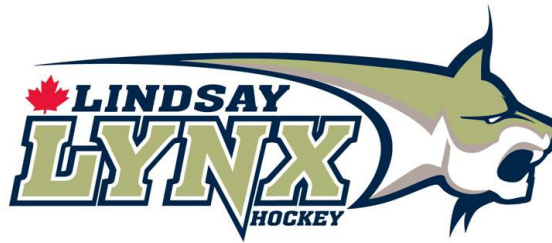


Registration Information for Representative Hockey 2010-11



We would like to take this opportunity to welcome new and returning players to the Lindsay Girls Hockey Association.

To Play on a Representative Team:

1. Registration must be completed in full (all required forms and all post-dated cheques)
2. Must attend two try-outs in the spring. (May 12, 13, 19, 20; watch newspaper ads for specific times and dates) Girls coming from another girl's hockey organization will require a permission to skate.
3. Where there is sufficient numbers the team for the B and C level at each division will be selected and rostered at this time. (Atom (00-01), Pee Wee (98-99), Bantam (96-97), and Midget (93-95))

When can I register?

Registration will start at the Lynx banquet on Friday April 23, 2010 at Lindsay Collegiate and Vocational Institute. All registrations must be made in person. There will be other dates for registration at the Lindsay recreation complex, please watch the papers. Registration closes May 31st.

Can I register after the deadline date of May 28th ?

LGHA will only accept registration forms to fill up a division after that date; others will be put on a waiting list. Any registrations made after this date must be paid in full, and a late fee will apply.

What are the costs?

Before May 28th

After May 28th
\$700.00

Is there a payment plan?

Payments can be divided into three parts, and post dated as follows:

	Post-date	Amount
1	May 28, 2010	\$200.00
2	July 16, 2010	\$150.00
3	September 3, 2010	\$250.00

Each registration fee includes 10 lottery calendars that can be sold for \$10.00 each to recover some of your costs.

Official receipts will be issued later in the hockey season for income tax purposes.

What if my daughter does not make the rep team?

All players who want to try out for the rep team must register as a rep player, and must be fully registered as a rep player to sign the team roster. If your child tries out but does not make any available rep team, and would like to play house league your third payment cheque will be returned, and you will be paid in full.

What do I need if I didn't play for LGHA last year?

If you played for another OWA association you will need a player release form from that association. If you played for an OMHA team you may transfer without any forms. All new registrants will need to bring their birth certificate or passport to registration.

All registrations are in person only.
